



15 items you should have in your "stay home" emergency kit

(Expected event duration, 4+ days)

- Water** - 1 gallon/person/pet/day
- Food** - non-perishable; pull-tab tops
- Combo radio/flashlight** - hand crank or extra batteries
- Whistle** - to signal for help
- First-Aid Kit & Manual**
- Sanitation Supplies** - TP/feminine hygiene
- Sanitizer/sanitary wipes**
- Solar phone charger**
- Rx medications & eyeglasses**
- Sturdy walking shoes**
- Multi-purpose tool**
- Face masks** - rated N95 or better
- Vinyl gloves**
- Mylar blankets**
- Infant & pet supplies**
- Tent or tarps and duct tape**



20 additional items for

(Expected event duration of 4+ days)

- Cash-** at least \$500+ in small bills
- Complete change of clothing** - for various seasons
- Water purification kit**
- Lighter or waterproof matches**
- ID & important docs** - in waterproof container & in cloud
- Fire extinguisher**
- Mess kits** - or paper plates, cups, plastic utensils
- Paper & pencil**
- Help/Okay banner** - to signal neighbors/first-responders
- Books, games, playing cards** - activities to distract
- Teddy bears** - comfort items for children
- Sleeping bags**
- Tools** - shovel, crowbar, hammer
- Personal hygiene items** - toothbrush, comb, wash cloth
- Medical equipment** - for special needs
- Camp stove & fuel**
- 5-gallon buckets** - for sanitation
- Garbage bags & ties** - for sanitation
- Rain ponchos**
- House & car keys** - extra sets in contractor lock box
